STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR POLICY CONCERNING THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE POLICY AND FINANCING'S ACCESS TO CERTAIN COMPILED COURT RECORDS

- 1. <u>RECITALS & PURPOSE</u>. Justice-involved individuals experience significant unresolved physical and behavioral health concerns as compared to the general population that contribute to increased recidivism and system costs. Access to health care coverage and services is associated with reduced recidivism and cost savings in both the justice and healthcare systems. The State Court Administrator ("SCA") and the Department of Health Care Policy and Financing ("HCPF") seek to improve outcomes for probationers who are eligible for Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program), which is administered by HCPF. In support of this goal, HCPF seeks compiled court records of eligible probationers.
- 2. <u>AUTHORITY</u>. The SCA sets this Policy pursuant to Chief Justice Directive ("CJD") 05-01 Section 2.00(b)(3).
- 3. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Policy shall be effective upon the date it is executed by the State Court Administrator.
- 4. EXCEPTIONS TO CJD 05-01. Compiled court records shared by the SCA with HCPF pursuant to any data share agreement entered into for purposes of this Policy are not subject to the restrictions of CJD 05-01 Sections 4.60(e)(4) and 4.60(e)(6), provided that probationers whose information will be within the compiled court records have previously signed appropriate releases of information.
