Gov. Hickenlooper appoints new district court judge in 7th Judicial District

DENVER – Friday, Feb. 19, 2016 – Gov. John Hickenlooper today announced his appointment of Keri Yoder to fill a vacancy in the 7th Judicial District (Delta, Gunnison, Hinsdale, Montrose, Ouray and San Miguel counties). The vacancy was created by the resignation of the Honorable Jeff B. Herron, effective March 1, 2016.

Yoder is currently an Assistant District Attorney in the District Attorney's Office in the 7th Judicial District where she has been prosecuting cases since 2002. Prior to becoming a prosecutor, she was a private practitioner at Overholser & Slee, LLC in Montrose and at Dufford, Waldeck, Milburn & Krohn, LLP in Grand Junction.
