Gov. Hickenlooper appoints judge to 10th Judicial District

DENVER — Monday, Nov. 14, 2016 — Gov. John Hickenlooper today appointed Allison Ernst to fill a position on the District Court in the 10th Judicial District (Pueblo County). Ernst will fill a vacancy created by the retirement of the Honorable David W. Crockenberg.

Ernst is currently an owner and partner at Becker & Ernst, LLC, where her practice consists primarily of criminal, domestic relations, restraining order and probate matters. Additionally, she serves as a member and secretary of the City of Pueblo Zoning Board of Appeals. Before entering private practice, Ernst was a Deputy Colorado State Public Defender in Pueblo. She also completed an Equal Justice Works Fellowship at the Michigan State University College of Law Low Income Taxpayer Clinic. Ernst earned her undergraduate degree from Michigan State University and her J.D. from the Detroit College of Law at Michigan State University.
