Gov. Hickenlooper appoints Adams County court judges

DENVER — Thursday, June 9, 2016 — Gov. John Hickenlooper today appointed Cindy Hoang-Ha Thi Dang and Martin “M.J.” Flaum to serve as county court judges in Adams County, which is in the 17th Judicial District. The vacancies are a result of the retirements of the Honorable Robert S. Doyle and the Honorable Jeffrey L. Romeo.

Ha Dang serves as a Magistrate in the 17th Judicial District, a position she has held since 2013. Her docket consists mainly of domestic relations cases. She previously presided over small claims cases, civil protection order cases, criminal advisements and bond hearings. Prior to serving as a judicial officer, Ha Dang was a general practitioner and a Deputy District Attorney in the Fourth Judicial District.

Ha Dang earned her undergraduate degree from the University of California, Irvine in 1994 and her Juris Doctor from California Western School of Law in 1996. Her appointment is effective July 1, 2016.

Flaum serves as a Senior Lead Deputy District Attorney in the 17th Judicial District, a position he has held since 2014. His practice focuses on felony prosecutions including homicide, sexual assault, vehicular homicide, assault, drug distribution, theft and domestic violence. Prior to his current role, Flaum served as a Deputy District Attorney in the 17th Judicial District.

Flaum earned his undergraduate degree from the University of Nebraska in 2003 and his Juris Doctor from Creighton University in 2009.

His appointment is effective January 10, 2017.
