Gov. Hickenlooper appoints new county court judge in 7th Judicial District

DENVER – Wednesday, Oct. 18, 2017 – Gov. John Hickenlooper today appointed Zachary Martin to the Ouray County Court in the 7th Judicial District. He fills a vacancy created by the appointment of the Honorable Cory Jackson to the District Court.

Martin currently serves as a Senior Deputy Public Defender in the Montrose Office of the Colorado State Public Defender (2013 - present).
