Gov. Hickenlooper appoints new county court judge in Fifth Judicial District

DENVER – Wednesday, March 14, 2018 – Gov. John Hickenlooper today appointed Cynthia Jones as a Clear Creek County Court Judge in the Fifth Judicial District. She fills a vacancy created by the appointment of the Honorable Rachel Olguin-Fresquez to the Eagle County Court.

Jones currently runs her private practice, Law Office of Cynthia J. Jones, LLC, where she focuses on criminal law. She is also the primary Alternate Defense Counsel for Eagle County, but has taken cases in Summit, Lake, and Garfield Counties as well. Previously, Jones served in the Office of the Colorado Public Defender as a Deputy State Public Defender, from 2001-2013 as well as from 1993-1998. Jones was an Associate Attorney at Bailey & Peterson, P.C., from 1999-2001, where she practiced primarily in civil litigation. She received her undergraduate degree from the University of Colorado in 1989, her Juris Doctor from the University of Montana in 1992, and a Masters of Art History from Southern New Hampshire University in 2017.

Jones' appointment was effective Feb. 1, 2018.
