## **Gov. Hickenlooper appoints new Eagle County Court judge**

**DENVER — Wednesday, Jan. 17, 2018** — Gov. John Hickenlooper today appointed Rachel Olguin-Fresquez to the Eagle County Court in the Fifth Judicial District. She fills a vacancy created by the resignation of the Honorable Katherine T. Sullivan.

Olguin-Fresquez currently serves as a County Court judge in Clear Creek County, a position she has held since 2006. In this capacity, she handles both criminal and civil matters. Previously, Olguin-Fresquez was a Deputy District Attorney in the 5th Judicial District from 1999-2006. She earned her undergraduate degree from the University of Colorado in 1991 and her JD from Tulane University School of Law in 1998.

Olguin-Fresquez' appointment is effective immediately.
