Having reviewed the enabling statute for the Office of Public Guardianship pilot project, please summarize for us what you believe to be the scope and goals of the pilot project and the preferred outcome?

Clarification of any items on the resume or in the written responses of the application packet (as determined by the Commission members).

Describe what you believe to be the primary challenges in completing the pilot project and steps you might take to address them?

Describe your understanding of the process and procedures for guardianship in Colorado.

The OPG will interact with a large number of community and governmental stakeholders. Tell us about a time you had to actively seek collaborative relationships with governmental and community stakeholders to complete a project. What was your role in the project and how did you ensure engagement from participants? Describe how you managed conflict among or between stakeholders.
