Background of the OPG Commission

Pursuant to § 13-94-104(1), C.R.S. (2017), the Colorado General Assembly created the Office of Public Guardianship Commission and Office within the Judicial Department. The Commission is comprised of 5 members. Three of the members are appointed by the Colorado Supreme Court, of which two must be attorneys admitted to practice law in Colorado and one must be a resident of Colorado not admitted to practice law. The remaining two members are appointed by the Governor, one who must be an attorney admitted to practice law in this state and one who must be a resident of Colorado not admitted to practice law.

The Commission is charged with appointing the Director for the Office of the Public Guardianship when at least \$1.7 million is raised from gifts, grants or donations. The Director, once appointed, serves at the pleasure of the Commission pursuant to § 13-94-104(3), C.R.S. (2017). The OPG Office/Commission is a pilot program effective until June 30, 2021, at which time the agency will either continue, discontinue, or be expanded by the General Assembly pursuant to § 13-94-111, C.R.S. (2017).
